Puerto Rico. Dave Hogg's VLBA Memo #312 describes his analysis of water vapor fluctuations on Puerto Rico. These measurements were made partly to determine if Puerto Rico is an acceptable VLBA site, and if possible to quantify the effect of water vapor fluctuations on different parts of its island. At this time we need to either accept or reject Puerto Rico as a VLBA site, noting that the latter choice would involve a reassessment of the whole configuration. Assuming that the Committee agrees that Puerto Rico is acceptable, it may also wish to make a preliminary comparison of the different sites; however, a choice among these sites cannot be made until the sites are examined by the Site Group.
