PRESENT: BENSON, BRUNDAGE, CRANE, HOGG, HVATUM, TEMPLE, WALKER, PEERY

D. HOGG ADVISED THAT THE JPL EQUIPMENT FOR WATOR VAPOR TESTS IN HAWAII WILL PROBABLY BE AVAILABLE BY THE END OF SEPTEMBER. HE IS PROCEEDING TO CONTACT APPROPRIATE PEOPLE IN HAWAII RELATIVE TO THESE TESTS.

B. BRUNDAGE GAVE A BRIEF REVIEW OF RFI TESTS MADE BY THE PEOPLE AT HAYSTACK. THE RESULTS ARE VERY DISCOURAGING. HE WILL PREPARE A MEMO, WHICH WILL GIVE A COMPLETE SUMMARY OF THE TEST DATA RECEIVED AND THE NTIA STUDY, FOR DISTRIBUTION. THE PLANS ARE TO SEND THE NRAO RFI TRAILER TO HAYSTACK AFTER THE IOWA SITE SURVEY.

THE NRAO RFI TRAILER HAS BEEN MOVED TO THE PIE TOWN SITE TO MAKE THE SURVEY THERE.

REQUEST FOR THE TITLE TO PROPERTY AT THE PIE TOWN SITE IS MOVING ALONG. WE UNDERSTAND THERE ARE SOME MINOR TECHNICAL QUESTIONS COMING.

A LETTER TO LOS ALAMOS HAS BEEN WRITTEN AND IS BEING EDITED BEFORE MAILING.

THE SEARCH FOR AN A/E FOR THE SITES AND AOC IS PROCEEDING.

DISCUSSIONS WITH NMIMT AS TO THE LOCATION OF THE AOC ARE GOING WELL.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SITE CONTROL BUILDING ARE COMING IN. WE APPEAR TO BE CLOSE TO FINALIZING THESE REQUIREMENTS.

NOTHING NEW ON THE ISLAND OF ST. CROIX AS A POSSIBLE SITE.

STATUS OF OTHER SITES AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED.
