- 5. BUS: MAG How will design be selected?

HH - And when?

JMP - Needs to have iterative process early for electronics.

HH - Get WGH, JMP and possibly P. Rhodes to CV on June 30 to meet with HH, GRP, JWF, LK.

Tasks: Review 2 or 3 designs. See compatibility with electronics, etc. Advise WGH on most suitable design. What further analysis needs to be done before a choice is made?

After a choice, WGH carries through final design.

MAG - Why not buy an ESSCO BUS?

WGH - Ours more suitable.

- 6. General: JMP and JWF will need design effort from GB fairly soon.
 - HH Perhaps bring R. Moore into these meetings.
