As of this date, information gained from North American Van Lines, furnished by their representative Mrs. Birch for the use of an air ride van for transporting panels to Green Bank from plant, was determined to be $\$ 2,600.00$ per trip. It is understood there will be two shipments or a total of $\$ 5,200.00$.

For information purposes only, if it was determined to move the panels from Green Bank to Tucson at a later date, the charge would be $\$ 5,635.00$ per trip or a total of $\$ 11,270.00$.

For comparison purposes only, for the above services as discussed in paragraph one, for standard box trailer would be $\$ 756.60$ per trip or a total of $\$ 1,513.20$.
