Dear Mr. Becker:

We are seriously concerned with the increasing delay in delivery stemming from non-delivery to you of the azimuth bearing by your subcontractor. While we are sympathetic to the manufacturing problems of your bearing subcontractor, his non-delivery to you is not an excuseably delay under Schedule B, Article 5, of this subcontract. Further delay in completion of the antenna may seriously jeopardize completion in time to meet the requirements of our sponsor's program, as well as increase overall costs.

The requirements for the completion of the overall program have been thoroughly reviewed by our technical staff. Based on this review, AUI agrees to extend the date when the antenna is complete and ready for delivery to the site to November 24, 1982.

Further slippage of this critical date may result in termination for default in accordance with Schedule B, Article 5, without further notification to TIW. AUI's agreement to extend delivery shall not result in any increase in the subcontract price or result in any modification or change in terms and conditions.
