Use of Pipeline during the week April 30 to May 4.

During the last week we have encountered two serious problems with the pipeline: 1) As a result of trying to rationalize frequency header information in the pipeline the UVFITS program is generating an output with incorrect frequencies and an incorrect W component of the baseline. 2) A hardware problem has occurred which is causing the mapping and cleaning programs to fail.

All the key people required to solve these problems are away until late this week. Consequently we have no alternative but to suspend use of the pipeline until we can make the necessary repairs.

I apologize for any inconvenience that this will cause you. We are willing to have your data written on UVFITS tape by our Dataanalyst when the program is working correctly. If you require this service fill in the enclosed form and give it to Ina Cole.
